Notice To Exhibitors

1. Conditional, telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries.
2. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
3. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink as entries will be photocopied. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries.
4. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. Email changes are allowed.
5. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** — Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
6. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
7. **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent after the closing date to the mailing address on the Official AKC Entry Form. In addition, it will be emailed electronically to the email address if provided. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, please notify the Show Secretary.
8. **DECLINATION OF ENTRIES:** The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
9. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
10. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
11. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
12. **NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA** except those regularly entered in the show. There will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs at this show. All dogs shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
13. **ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The show-giving club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
14. The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Doberman Pinscher Club of Northern California will not be responsible for loss. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.

Neutered dogs and spayed bitches may be entered and shown in veteran classes at independent specialty shows.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed or Variety competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record, or Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the day of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owners' records.

SPECIAL AWARDS

- **Owner-Handled Best of Breed** - See information on Page 8.
- **Best Puppy in Regular Classes** – Chosen from the winners of Puppy Dogs 6-9, Puppy Dogs 9-12, Puppy Bitches 6-9, Puppy Bitches 9-12, BBE Puppy Dogs, and BBE Puppy Bitches. If a puppy entrant is chosen Best of Breed or Best of Winners, then it is automatically awarded Best Puppy.
- **Best Veteran** – Chosen from the winners of the Veterans Dog and Veterans Bitch classes.
- **Awards of Merit** – At the conclusion of Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Select Dog and Select Bitch, **TWO** (2) Awards of Merit may be given at the judge's discretion to entries in BOB competition. The judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. All dogs competing in the Best of Breed competition are eligible for this award, with the exception of the Best of Breed winner. A Rosette will be given to the Award of Merit selections.

SWEEPSTAKES RULES

This Sweepstakes is open to all Doberman Pinschers who, on the date of the show, shall be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. All dogs shown in sweepstakes must be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee, and on the same entry form. Sweepstakes classes will be judged before the regular breed classes. Junior and Senior stakes will be judged separately. Champions may **not** be entered in Sweepstakes. This includes dogs which have achieved championships according to their owners' records as of close of entries. **Please indicate your Sweepstakes class with the appropriate age division** in the space provided for in "Additional Classes". Entry fee for Puppy Sweepstakes is \$25.00 in addition to the regular class entry fee.

AKC National Owner-Handled Series

OFFERED BOTH SHOWS

Determining Eligibility:

- Exhibitors must declare their dog AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the CHECK BOX on the entry form.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the steward's book and in the show catalog.
- Professional handler, household members and current assistants to professional handlers in conformation are not eligible to exhibit in this competition. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.
- Professional handler is defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.
- Dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for the AKC NOHS throughout the breed level (all classes, Winners, and Best of Breed) competition. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner/handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition (Group and Best in Show). Any person may exhibit the dog in the regular Group and Best in Show competitions.
- Eligibility restrictions apply to all members of the same household.
- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed/Variety competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes. *This excludes all dogs defeated during class and winners competition for the regular show.*

Determining Owner-Handled Best of Breed

- Breed judging for OH Best of Breed is conducted following Best of Breed judging in the ring. All dogs in BOB competition (including WD & WB) will stay in the ring after the judge makes their placements. The ring steward will ask all professional handlers, household members, and current assistants to a professional handler, and any exhibitor that did not indicate on their entry that they were eligible for NOHS to leave the ring. The judge will then select the Owner-Handled Best of Breed. A dog being "cut" or otherwise "defeated" in the BOB ring remains eligible to compete for Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
