## Clean Up Is Your Responsibility !!!!!

- If your dog soils the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for these dog shows you are agreeing that clean up is your responsibility.
- Exhibitors and Handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and setups.

## Special Attention

- Do not leave dogs in closed vehicles.
- No owner or agent shall allow his/her animals to be put in jeopardy of the elements or dangerous conditions.
- If it is necessary to rescue a dog from a parked car on the show grounds, the LCKCC and event committee will not be held responsible or liable for any damage to the vehicle involved.

## Pre-Ordered Catalogs

Only a few LCKCC catalogs will be available for exhibitors to purchase at the trials. To pre-order a catalog (to include all 6 events) to be picked up at the show, use the Official AKC Entry Form, check the box for Pre-Ordered Catalog, and enclose an additional \$5.00 per catalog with your entry fees. Catalogs must be picked up at the trials, they will not be mailed.

## Notice to Exhibitors

- CONDITIONAL, TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE, AND UNSIGNED ENTRIES ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE.** Entries must be on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms and **MUST** include the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form.
- Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries. Highest price class is considered first entry. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
- PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries. Generic entry forms are available on-line at [www.going-2-dogs.com](http://www.going-2-dogs.com).
- Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. Email or faxed changes are allowed.
- ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** — Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
- Information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the event catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.
- ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the event, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
- BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter may be required.
- CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. It will also be emailed electronically if an email address is included on the entry form. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the event, please notify the Event Secretary.
- DECLINATION OF ENTRIES:** The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
- THE TRIAL SITE WILL BE AVAILABLE FROM 8:00 AM** until one hour after conclusion of events. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and/or its Event Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
- There are no provisions for unentered dogs at this show. All dogs must be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged in the competition ring.
- ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Event Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The Club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors, alone, are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and their children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such cases, no refund of any entry fees paid will be made.
- The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Club will not be responsible for loss. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
- THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.**
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.**

- **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete in Obedience or Rally. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter may be required.

- Exhibitors should specify their dog's jump height for classes with jumps. Dogs will not be separated by jump heights.

### Rally Trial Information

- RAE Class offered.
- Rally exhibitors **MUST** specify their dog's jump height for Advanced & Excellent classes.  
 4" For dogs under 10" at withers.      12" For dogs 15" and under 20" at withers.  
 8" For dogs 10" and under 15" at withers.      16" For dogs 20" and over.
- Dogs will be judged in DESCENDING height order in Rally classes with jumps.
- Rally Ring size will be approximately 40 by 50 feet.
