ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES. Entries are accepted in order of receipt. The Trial Secretary will use all information to fairly and equitably determine which entries are received first. Each entrant will receive an emailed acknowledgement when the entry is processed. This does not guarantee that your entry is within the limit for the Trial. Please check your dog's information and classes carefully and contact the Trial Secretary with any corrections. If you do not list an email address and you wish to receive confirmation of your entry, enclose a SSAE which will be returned to you.

EMAILED / FAX ENTRIES. See Page 9 for instructions for emailed or faxed entries. No entries will be accepted by phone or hand delivery. Special delivery mail which requires a signature may be delayed or refused. Note that Fed Ex and UPS cannot deliver to a P.O. Box. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

JUDGING PROGRAM. After entries have closed and within one week of the Trials, each exhibitor will be emailed the Judging Schedule with their catalog number and actual time and location for check-in. Exhibitors without an email address on their entry forms will receive a printed copy of the Schedule mailed to them. If you wish both email and printed schedule, please check box on entry form. Contact the Trial Secretary - Debi Best at DLBest7@earthlink.net if you have not received a schedule seven days prior to trial.

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing / Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number. Approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate. Aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from an injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

The A/B Sections: The Novice A Class is for beginners. Those dogs that have earned a title in that element (in AKC or in another organization), and those handlers who have worked as professional detection dog handlers must enter the B section. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es). Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of qualifying scores.

Handlers may not handle more than one dog in each class. Multiple dogs from the same owner may be entered in the same class, provided they are run by different handlers.

NO MOVE-UP TRANSFERS are allowed at these trials. Only one level is offered at each trial. However, if your dog completes a title in the Novice trials, you may enter the Advanced Trial (Sun PM) the day of the event before 12:00 Noon.

Wait List Information

Lost Coast Kennel Club of California will keep a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 overflow entries per trial will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary by the closing date (January 17, 2018) except for the Advanced trial in which case day-of-entries will be accepted. No entry may be withdrawn for a refund after closing on January 17, 2018, unless the withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, in which case a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Check-In, Staging Area, Handler's Briefing, Warm-Up Information

Exhibitors must check in by the specified time EACH DAY they are entered. At check-in you receive will your armband number(s), a list of the running order, a locally made chocolate bar, and a raffle ticket. One chocolate bar and raffle ticket per exhibitor for the weekend.

MORNING CHECK-IN will be from 7:30-8:00 AM each day. Morning handler's briefing will be at 8:15 AM. Morning judging begins at 8:30 AM or at conclusion of handler's briefing.

AFTERNOON CHECK-IN for exhibitors not entered in morning trial: 11:30 AM - 12:00 Noon each day. Judging schedule will include times for afternoon briefing, with judging to follow. If the Advanced Trial on Sunday PM is not filled and if your dog has completed a Novice level title, then day-of-trial entries are accepted until 12:00 Noon.

STAGING AREA - The Staging Area will include the warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results. It will be out of view of the search area(s). Crating space for dogs may be available.

HANDLER'S BRIEFING will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there's an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

WARM-UP AREA. A Warm-Up Area will be available consisting of ONE container of Birch (or Anise for Trial #4) and may also consist of blank containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to (2) two minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

Search Area and Conditions

Search areas may be of any shape, and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class.

SEARCH AREA CONDITIONS. Searches may be indoors on matted, carpeted, wooden, concrete or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, mulch, concrete, brick or asphalt surfaces. Searches are frequently done across natural, uneven surfaces and handlers should be aware of and prepared for this possibility.

Additional Site Information

TRIAL SITE. It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

POSSESSION OF ODORS AND TRAINING. Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".

SPECTATOR AREA. Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run except in the case of Handler Discrimination classes. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be ask to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

CRATING SPACE may be available in the staging area. Please, no disruptive dogs in this area. Dogs may be crated in vehicles. The exhibitor is responsible to know when to be in the staging area.

WEATHER. Be prepared for wet cold weather conditions. Dress appropriately. The location is very close to the ocean and is not expected to freeze.

Ribbons, Awards, and Prizes

Qualifying scores are required for winning of any awards. Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

HIGH IN TRIAL. Only teams who participate in all classes offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried), and who qualify in each class are eligible to win **High in Trial**. One High In Trial winner is chosen at each level. There is no separate High In Trial for the Novice A and Novice B sections. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across the elements will be summed and the faster-finishing team will win. If the times are tied, the winner is chosen by coin-flip.

Volunteer Sign-Up

Volunteers who are selected to assist at the trial(s) will receive entry preference. We will accept up to 15 volunteers each day. Volunteers will be selected according to their experience in the position(s) for which they are volunteering and the needs of the trial. Volunteers who are given an assignment during a class in which they are entered will run their dog prior to assuming their assignment. The deadline to submit volunteer information and be considered for entry preference is January 12, 2018.

Pre-Ordered Catalogs

If you wish to pre-purchase a trial catalog with all four events, please indicate on the check-box on the Official Entry Form. Enclose additional \$5.00 for each catalog pre-ordered by January 17, 2018. A very small number of additional catalogs will be available at the trials for \$10.00 each.

Friday Afternoon Gathering

The Club will have a welcome gathering and a fun "Sniff and Go" on Friday, February 2, 2018, to be held near the RV park at the west end of the Fairgrounds. The club will welcome exhibitors arriving from out of town and introduce them to Ferndale. More information will be included in the Judging Schedule.

Hospitality

The Club will offer morning hospitality to exhibitors both Saturday and Sunday - coffee, tea, fruit and pastries.

No food will be available for purchase at the trial site. Exhibitors should plan to bring their own lunch and beverages. There are restaurants and stores a few minutes away in Ferndale.

Notice To Exhibitors

THIS CLUB DOES NOT AGREE TO ARBITRATE CLAIMS AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM FOR THIS EVENT.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY. The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Lost Coast Kennel Club of California reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the LCKCC.

COLLARS, LEASHES AND HARNESSSES. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. Nothing may be hanging from the dog's collar or harness, except that a wearable camera such as a Go-Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS. An exhibitor may withdraw his entry before the closing date of Wednesday, January 17, 2018, at 11:59 PM and receive a full refund of entry fees. Dogs withdrawn after closing date (January 17, 2018) because of injury, medical condition, or any other reason are not eligible for a refund, unless replaced by an entry from the wait list. If the withdrawn dog is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, loss of site, extreme weather conditions, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds of less than \$3.00 will not be issued due to the cost of processing.

BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete in Scent Work competition. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season, the entry fee will be refunded provided that the Trial Secretary is notified in writing no later than one half hour prior to the first class of the trial. A **processing fee of \$6.00 per entry** will be retained by the club. A signed veterinarian's letter may be required.

REACTIVE DOGS are allowed, but must be kept separate and in leash control at all times. Dogs should not be allowed to interact during the trials. All exhibitors must be respectful of everyone's space and control their dogs at all times.

RINGSIDE. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the search area when required.

CLEAN-UP. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the trial grounds.

SCENT WORK REGULATIONS. All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website or ordering a rulebook from www.akc.org.

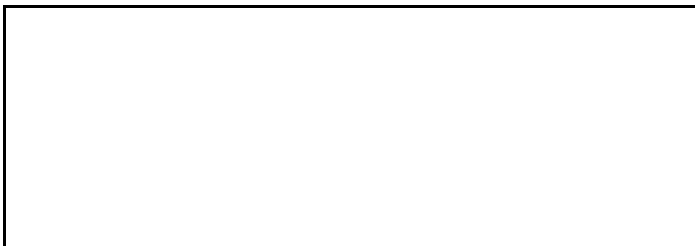
