Dogs may arrive any time prior to scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused. Judges are not required to wait for any dog. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. Judges may take breaks at their discretion. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged. No practicing allowed in rings at any time.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- **NO MOVE-UPS** will be allowed at these Trials.
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
- **NO FOOD IS AVAILABLE ON THE GROUNDS - PLEASE BRING YOUR OWN SNACKS AND LUNCH.**
- **SELF-SERVICE SPECIAL AWARD BINDER:** The Club will use a **Special Award Binder** at the trial to determine the winner of the following special awards. **IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR ANY OF THE SPECIAL AWARDS**, you must enter your armband number on the tote sheet for each award for which you are eligible. Awards will be based on the information the handlers have entered on the tote sheets only. If you do not complete the tote sheet information, you will not be eligible for any of the Special Awards. High in Trial and High Combined are not required to complete the self-service special award binder.

DIRECTIONS TO SANTA CLARA COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS - Take Highway 101 north or south to San Jose. Take the Tully exit westbound. Follow Tully approximately 1.5 miles to Fairgrounds. On-grounds parking is available near the trial site. To reach on-grounds parking, make U-turn at 7th Street, enter fairgrounds at Gate B. Parking fee \$10.00 per day.
