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## Obedience Trial Information

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- Please specify dog's jump height on entry form.
- Dogs will be separated by jump height and run in **DESCENDING order starting at 36"**.
- Dogs without jump heights on entry form will be judged at the end of the class.
- UDX and Preferred UDX classes offered.
- **CLASS TRANSFERS** will be allowed provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests will be accepted from the day after close of entries until 30 minutes before the trial available,

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## Notice To Exhibitors

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- **CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or telephoned entries will not be accepted.** Entries without fees cannot be accepted. See Page 5 for information on emailed entries.
- **ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS** or photocopies of entry forms without the **Agreement** and Instructions on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- **PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY** using black or blue ink.
- **OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS** on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.
- **CHANGES, ADDITIONS, OR CORRECTIONS** to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Emailed changes are acceptable. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- **AN AKC RECORDING & EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.50 WILL BE REQUIRED FOR EACH ENTRY** at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. These fees are included in the stated entry fees and paid to the American Kennel Club. (Effective Jan 1, 2024)
- **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$8.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
- **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- **THE WELL-BEING OF DOGS** and participants is of paramount importance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fee(s) will be made. **DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS IN A HOT VEHICLE.**
- **RECEIPT OF ENTRY.** An emailed acknowledgement will be sent upon receipt of entry to the email address listed on the entry form. If exhibitor does not hear within a reasonable time, please contact the Trial Secretary before closing date.
- **THE JUDGING SCHEDULE** with armband assignment will be sent to the email address on the Official AKC entry form approximately one week before the trial. If the exhibitor wishes to have a **printed** schedule mailed, please request on the entry form.
- **CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM** for time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs at ringside when it is their turn to be judged. Dogs need to be at the trial only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
- **DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH** except when being judged in the ring.
- **THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING** nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- **NO PROVISIONS** will be made for unentered dogs on the grounds.
- **IN THE CASE OF A TIE** for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
- **ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED THE DAY OF THE TRIAL. NONE WILL BE MAILED** or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for an award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award
- **THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY,** their agents or employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to any **CHILD** not under the control of their parents or guardians.

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## Grounds Information

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These events will be held on private property. Please be respectful of the owners and their home and business.

- Park in the lot designated as RV parking. Follow those signs. Do not park by the kennel buildings.
- Clean up after your dog(s). Dispose of dog waste in buckets specifically for that purpose. Please do not use the garbage bins for dog waste.
- Dispose of garbage in containers placed on the show grounds.
- Only **solid-bottom crates** (plastic trays) are allowed in the covered arena where the rings are located. **NO EX-PENS ARE ALLOWED IN THE COVERED ARENA.**
- Exhibitors may also place setups on the Lake Lawn area near by. All crates, mats or anything with a solid bottom must be pulled off the lawn at the end of the day. Nothing should be left on the lawn overnight.
- Do not allow your dog(s) to dig at the lawn or artificial turf areas.
- Absolutely no dogs or people are permitted on the dock or in the pool, including entrance and exit ramps.
- Exhibitors should bring their own meals and snacks. No food vendors are available on site.

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## Clean Up Is Your Responsibility !!!

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If your dog soils the grounds it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form for these dog shows you are agreeing that clean up is your responsibility. Violators may be reported to the event committee for disciplinary action.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. - (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in. over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
