## <u>DIRECTIONS TO SHOW GROUNDS - FROM SAN FRANCISCO / VALLEJO</u> -



- Take EASTBOUND I-80 to Dixon.
- Take Dixon Avenue/West A Street exit and go right onto West A.
- Drive approximately 2 miles, turn right onto South First Street at the signal in the middle of town.
- Continue a few blocks to the Fairgrounds on the left.

#### **DIRECTIONS TO SHOW GROUNDS - FROM SACRAMENTO -**

- Take WESTBOUND I-80, go west to Dixon.
  - Take Hwy 113 South exit. (Hwy 113 is First Street).
- Dixon May Fairgrounds is on the left, one-half mile past the traffic signal at First & A Streets.

#### DAY-OF-SHOW PARKING AND UNLOADING

Parking fee is \$10.00 per day for Friday, Saturday and Sunday. PARKING WILL NOT BE ALLOWED ON GROUNDS. You may unload on the show grounds, but MUST move your vehicle to the large parking lot across the street from the Fairgrounds.

<u>Directions to On-Call Veterinarian</u>: From the fairgrounds, go north on So. First Street (travel back toward downtown Dixon - CA 113) to 449 N. First Street (0.7 miles past W. Cherry St.) The clinic is on the left (west) side of the road.

### EMERGENCY VETERINARIAN - U.C. DAVIS VETERINARY MEDICAL TEACHING HOSPITAL - SMALL ANIMAL CLINIC

1 Garrod Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, UC Davis, Davis, CA. Telephone (530) 752-1393. Call first.

<u>Directions to Emergency Veterinarian</u>: Take I-80 (east) to Hwy 113 North. Exit at the first exit off of 113 (Hutchison). Turn right onto Hutchison and turn right at the second light onto LaRue. Take the first right again onto Garrod. Where Garrod ends, go straight into the parking lot for the Small Animal Clinic. The entrance for emergency is on the right side of the building. There is a bell to ring for entry after hours.

Exhibitors should follow their own veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**Clean Up Is Your Responsibility !!!** If your dog soils the parking lot, show grounds or a ring, it is your responsibility to clean it up. By signing the entry form at this dog show you are agreeing that clean-up is your responsibility. Violators may be subject to a bench show committee hearing. Exhibitors, please, if you see an area that has not been cleaned up, notify a Club Member immediately. Thank you.
