Additional Obedience Trial Information

- **Limited Entry.** Obedience is limited to 40 entries. UDX and PUDX classes are offered, limited to 6 (combined).
- **Wait List.** If the entry limit is exceeded before the stated closing date, a Wait List will be established to fill openings created by entries withdrawn before closing. Wait-listed exhibitors will be notified whether their entry made it into the trial within three days after close of entries. The full entry fee shall be refunded to an entrant whose entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry.
- **Class Transfers** ("Move-Ups") will be permitted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of Obedience Regulations, provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests must be in writing to the Trial Secretary and will be accepted from the day after close of entries until 30 minutes before the trial judging begins. (Early notification is appreciated.)
- **Jump Heights.** Exhibitors must specify their dog's jump height on entry form for classes with jumps. Entries will be sorted by jump height in **DESCENDING ORDER** starting with 36". Dogs without jump heights on entry form will be judged at the end of the class.

Notice To Exhibitors

1. To be acceptable, an entry must be submitted with the required entry fee on an official American Kennel Club entry form, or copy, of the official AKC entry form with agreement and rules on the reverse. Please type or neatly print, using black or blue ink. Entries will be accepted by USPS MAIL only. Entries will not be accepted by hand delivery, Fed-Ex, or email.
2. The Club and/or the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for a wrong entry.
3. Entries without fees cannot be accepted. No entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Unsigned, incomplete, telephone entries will not be accepted.
4. The owner is responsible for errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No dog wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class after close of entries. Changes, additions, corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
5. **RECEIPT OF ENTRY:** The Trial Secretary will send an emailed acknowledgement within 7 days of receipt of entry.
6. If acknowledgement is not received by entrant prior to closing date, please notify the Trial Secretary.
7. **JUDGING PROGRAM** with armband assignment will be sent electronically approximately 8 days before the Trial. Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after their class has been judged. We suggest dogs be present one hour before scheduled time of judging.
8. Exhibitors and handlers alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. The Club and the Trial Secretary assume no responsibility in this regard.
9. The Club will exercise every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it must be understood that neither the Club nor the Trial Secretary will be responsible for loss or injury.
10. Dogs must be kept on leash except when in the judging ring.
11. There shall be no drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the Trial grounds or premises.
12. In case of a tie for any prizes, any dog that is not present for a run-off forfeits the right to the prize. No special award will be mailed or delivered. An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for a special award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award for him.
13. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the Club, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat or earthquakes, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
14. **CLASS TRANSFERS ARE ALLOWED.**
15. **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
16. **COVID-19 PROCEDURES** – All attendees are requested to follow CDC Guidelines regarding best practice measures and to adhere to any state, local or facility protocols pertaining to COVID-19 that may be in effect on the day of the event.

Grounds Information & Rules

1. NO overnight and NO day of RV parking.
2. NO smoking allowed on the grounds.
3. There will be a door monitor, you may not enter the building on your own.
4. Once you exit the ring, you will need to exit the building.
5. You will not be allowed to watch from inside the building.
6. Check-in will be done outside the building.
7. **NO CRATING IN THE BUILDING.** You will be required to crate from your vehicle. Bring canopies and/or shade cloth. Please keep dogs quiet. If barking cannot be controlled, you will be asked to leave. Keep dogs on leash while not working in the judging ring.
8. **NO DOG POTTY AREA ON SITE,** but there is a lawn a block away on Ward Street. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations near the show grounds. Additional information will be included in the judging program.

Directions to Veterinarian (from Trial Site):

- From parking lot go onto Ward Street.
- Go one block, then turn right onto Ferry St.
- Go two blocks and turn right onto Escobar.
- Continue onto Marina Vista eastbound about 1.4 m, take ramp and enter I-680 southbound.
- Take Interstate-680 south for 4 miles.
- Exit on Concord Ave (Exit 52) in Concord.
- Use left two lanes and turn left onto Contra Costa Blvd.
- Use left two lanes to turn left onto Concord Ave.
- Go 0.3 miles, turn right onto Meridian Park Blvd.
- In 0.3 miles turn right into parking lot.
- SAGE VET will be on your left across from DMV.

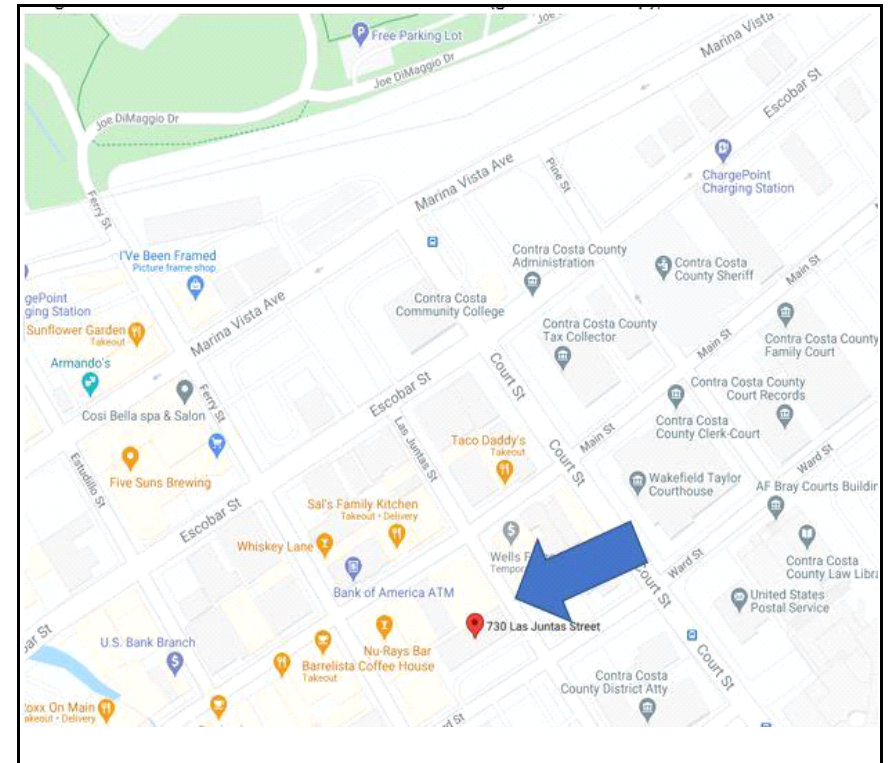
From Hwy 680 going Northbound (from Walnut Creek):
