

- Exhibitors must specify their dog's jump height on entry form (for classes with jumps).
- Dogs will be separated by jump height and run in ASCENDING order starting at 4".
- Dogs without jump heights on entry form will be judged at the end of the class.
- Obedience entries are limited to 30 entries.
- UDX class offered.

Rally Trial Information

- Exhibitors must specify the dog's rally jump height for Advanced, Excellent, Master classes
- Rally classes with jumps will be run in ASCENDING order starting with 4".
- Rally entries are limited to 30 entries.
- RAE and RACH classes are offered.
- Rally ring size to be 40' x 50'.

Wait List

These trials have limited entry. The Club will establish a wait list to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to close of entries. All entries must have been received prior to the closing date and time. The RALLY WAIT LIST will be held after closing to fill openings created by entries that are withdrawn prior to <u>Tuesday January 7</u> at 12:00 Noon. The full entry fee shall be refunded to an entrant whose entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry.

Class Transfers Are Allowed

Transfers may be approved provided the class is scheduled, the judge is available, and the class has not reached its limit. Transfer requests must be in writing and will be accepted from the day after close of entries until 30 minutes before each trial. Contact the Trial Secretary. Early notice is appreciated.

Special COVID-19 Information and Safety Protocols

- DO NOT COME TO THIS EVENT IF YOU FEEL SICK! If the Club is able to replace
 your entries from the wait list, your entry fees will be refunded.

Notice To Exhibitors

- CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or telephoned entries will not be accepted. Entries
 without fees cannot be accepted.
- ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the <u>Agreement</u> and Instructions on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- PLEASE TYPE OR PRINT CLEARLY using black or blue ink.
- OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS on entry blanks, for entering the same dog twice, or for
 entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.
- CHANGES, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries.
 Email and faxed changes are acceptable. Changes by telephone are not acceptable.
- An AKC RECORDING AND EVENT SERVICE FEE of \$3.50 will be required for every entry in any
 Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. Rally: An AKC Recording Fee of
 \$3.50 will be required for every entry in a Licensed or Member Rally Trial. These fees are included in the
 prices shown and are paid to the American Kennel Club.
- ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published
 closing date, nor in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by the Veterinarian or
 Judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee.
- THE WELL-BEING OF DOGS and participants is of paramount importance. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, loss of site, fire, Act of God, act of a public enemy, strikes, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or any other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refunds of entry fee(s) will be made. DO NOT LEAVE ANIMALS IN A HOT VEHICLE.
- BITCHES IN SEASON are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Trial Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained. A signed veterinarian's letter stating the bitch is in season must be provided as documentation with the request or within one week of the trial at the latest to receive a refund.
- ELECTRONIC CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the email
 address on the Official AKC entry form after the closing date. If the exhibitor wishes to have a printed
 schedule mailed, please request on the entry form. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the
 schedule within seven days of the trial, the Trial Secretary should be contacted.
- DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE TRIAL only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after unless required for further judging.
- CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM for time of judging. Exhibitors are responsible for having their dogs
 at ringside when it is their turn to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging may be excused after
 their class has been judged.
- DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON LEASH except when being judged in the ring.
- THERE SHALL BE NO DRILLING nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.
- Unentered dogs are not allowed in the trial building. No provisions will be made for unentered dogs on the grounds.
- In the case of a tie for any prize, any dog that is not present for a run-off will forfeit its rights to the prize.
- ALL AWARDS MUST BE CLAIMED THE DAY OF THE TRIAL. NONE WILL BE MAILED or delivered.
 An exhibitor whose dog is eligible for an award must be present or appoint a representative to accept the award
- THE TRIAL-GIVING CLUB, THE TRIAL SECRETARY, their agents or employees assume no
 responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, spectators, or to any of

Parking and Grounds Information

- NO RV PARKING is allowed either during the day or overnight. RV's are not allowed on the grounds.
- NO SMOKING is allowed on the grounds.
- PARKING IS LIMITED. Please do not arrive more than one hour before your class. If your class is completed and the parking area is near capacity, please leave to give space to another entrant.
- VEHICLES MAY NOT BE LEFT IDLING in the parking area.

 to leave. Dogs must be kept on leash except when working in the ring. Note:

 building, or back of building.
- Please stay away from the house area.
- CLEAN-UP. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any
 exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event
 Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning
 supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show
 grounds.
- NO FOOD VENDORS will be available at this event. Exhibitors should plan to bring their own snacks and beverages. Fast food is available approximately 15 minutes away.

Crating Rules and Trial Procedures

- Crating will be allowed in the building. You may only crate in the marked crating
 area between the RED CONES! NO X-PENS are allowed in the building. You
 must bring a clean mat or towel to put under your crate and chair. Space is
 limited. If the crating area fills up, you may crate outside on the patio or in your
 car. No dogs on the couch!
- NO crate aggressive dogs in the building. Please keep dogs quiet, if barking cannot be controlled you will be asked to leave. A dog not entered in the trial is not allowed in the building. There is room to warm up outside on the patio.
- Additional crating is allowed on the patio on the side of the building. Handlers
 may also work out of their car. Regardless of where handlers crate their dog, it
 is each handler's responsibility to know when it is their turn in the ring, and to be
 ready to go in the ring when it is their turn.
- CHECK-IN will be self-serve inside the building.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, particolor), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in, but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owners records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11. Section 3).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, particolor), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in, over 13 in, but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any show for which entries close after the date acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11. Section 3).
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
